- **Field Research, Story Collection & Sharing:** SJCA conducts field research and collects stories to gain insights into South Jersey's cultural landscape. By merging these narratives with data, SJCA advocates for increased funding and support for the arts, emphasizing their significance to the region's social and economic well-being.
- **South Jersey Virtual Features:** SJCA's Virtual Features showcase local artists and organizations through digital programming that enhances public awareness of the arts. This platform not only increases artist visibility but also provides audiences with access to diverse cultural experiences, contributing to a vibrant arts community.
- **Community Cultural Programs:** SJCA implements Community Cultural Programs that aim to deliver arts experiences to underserved populations by collaborating with local partners. These initiatives promote community engagement and strengthen connections between local artists, organizations, and residents.
- **Annual South Jersey Field Report:** The Annual South Jersey Field Report synthesizes research and stories to advocate for the arts in the region. - Regional & Local Convenings and Education Programs: SJCA organizes Regional and Local Convenings to facilitate collaboration, learning, and dialogue among stakeholders in the arts sector. - Advocacy with Statewide Partners & Funders: SJCA actively advocates for equitable access to
 resources and funding for the arts by collaborating with statewide partners and funders.

 Alliance, SJCA reinforces the case for support for South Jersey's arts community.
